Rules of Participation:

Entry

- **No Late entries will be accepted! Please ensure that you have entered by the due date – DO NOT ARRIVE AT THE COMPETITION VENUE ON THE DAY AND EXPECT TO FENCE WITHOUT HAVING PRE-ENTERED.**
- Provinces entering fencers, take into consideration your ***obligations to supply scoring apparatus and referees.***

Program

- An event will only held if four entries are received by the due date. Fencers will be notified as soon as possible if there are any changes to the program.
- No poule will be delayed because fencers are occupied with another bout.
- **Weapons-check** opening times displayed – fencers have to be finished by “roll-call”!
- THE COMPETITION WILL NOT BE DELAYED BY WAITING FOR FENCERS - IF A FENCER IS NOT AT ROLL CALL THEY WILL BE EXCLUDED.
- **Roll-call is half an hour before start times.** Fencers should ensure that they are at venue at least in time for weapon check.
- **Times:** events start at the “weapon check” for the specific weapon, and finish after **Prizegiving** for that weapon.

Equipment

- A plastron must be worn!
- Only breeches and long white socks may be worn! Fencers must please wear clean, indoor shoes
- Weapons, body wires, masks and electric jackets must be presented at the weapon's check.
- Any fencer on the piste must have access to 2 weapons and bodywires, working and having passed the weapons check.
